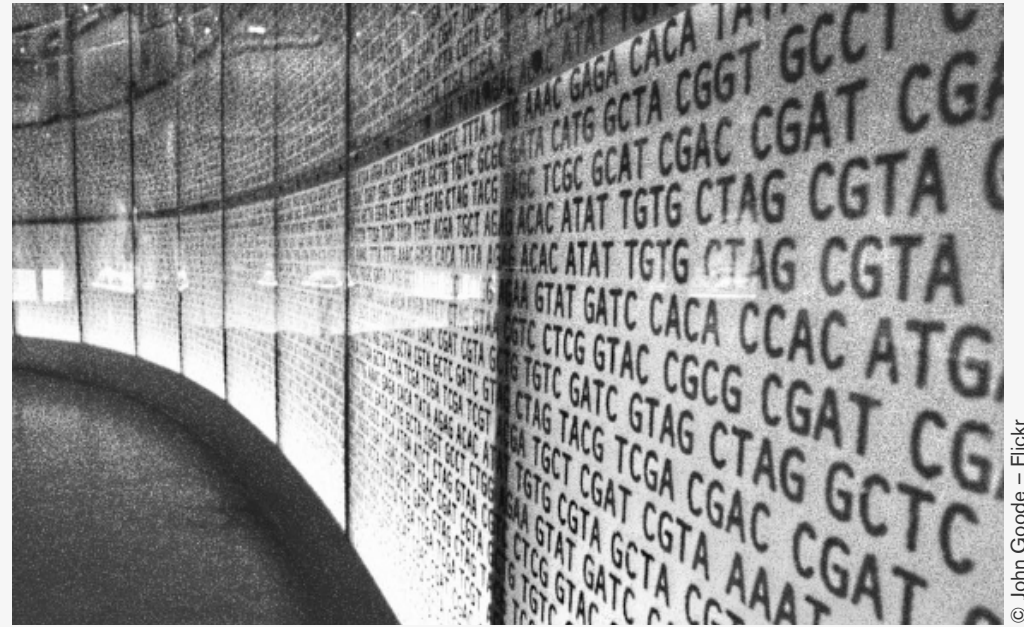

## Goals

EXCHANGE's ambition is twofold. First, to provide a comprehensive picture of transnational DNA data exchange in the EU. Second, to develop a comparative study involving the Netherlands, Poland, Portugal and the United Kingdom. The ultimate goal is to explore how forensic geneticists attribute meanings to controversial domains of social control of 'suspect populations' and the resulting implications for citizenship and democracy in the 21st century.
